- ➤ Make sure tasseled pull cords are short and continuous-loop cords are permanently anchored to the floor or wall

- ➤ Make sure cord stops are properly installed and adjusted to limit the movement of inner lift cords
- ➤ Lock cords into position whenever blinds or shades are lowered, including when they come to rest on a window sill
- ➤ Install cordless window treatments wherever young children play or sleep to eliminate the hazards of dangling cords and maximize safety
